BASIX enables realtime programming through the IR-remote control and functions also the connection between a PC and projectors. The status of the projectors

can be monitored on the LED-display. Furthermore there is an MIDI-interface which makes it possible to control the projectors through a MIDI-sequencer or MIDI-software.

With BASIX you can use projectors in multimedial setups for a reasonable price.

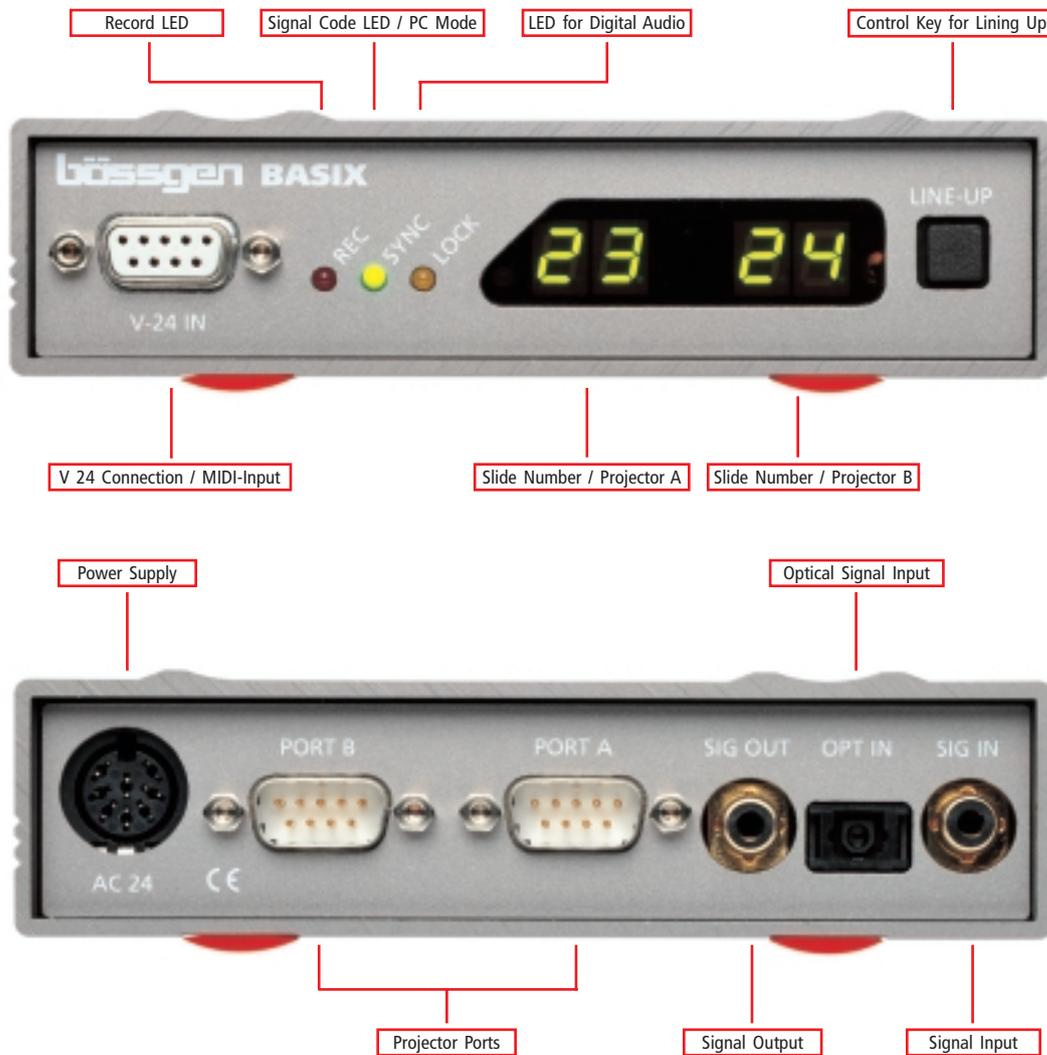
Open design

The versions

BASIX is available in a „basic“ version at an unusual low price for newcomers. BASIX „advanced“ is aimed to an experienced user. An extension may aquired at any time. The PC-software IMAGIX, digital recording on CD and timecode synchronization are also available with



BASIX advanced. BASIX extends with your increasing demands! BASIX advanced reads „our“ signals FreeTrac, PlusTrac and Dataton Syncode. Moreover, it reads those signals equally well whether coming from analog tape or having been encoded into digital audio. The basic version reads only analog PlusTrac.

Connections

Connecting cables are available for different types of projectors. BASIX is powered through the connected projectors. For Kodak and Leica projectors with a round slide tray and PCOM interface a AC-24 adapter is needed.

Infrared remote control

Important functions of BASIX can be remotely controlled. It controls focusing of Ektapro and Leica RT projectors. Here BASIX passes the command on to the active projector.
